

Book Review Format

I do not want your book review to be a simple summary of the book you read. I want you to concentrate on the characters of the novel and the role they play in the story. I want you to think about the conflict of the story and the role the characters play in the conflict. I also want you to think about the relevance of the title the author had chosen for that particular novel.

Information needed in the book review:

- Title and author
- List of characters - explain who are the main (major) characters and who are the minor characters. Tell the importance of the minor character's role.
- Explain what the main conflict is of the story. You do not need to tell how the conflict is resolved - leave that so others may be inspired to read the book.
- Finally, explain how the title is relevant to the whole storyline. Is the title appropriate, in your opinion?
